

Insurance is cheap when Homeowner takes in more financial risk, so understanding the risk is very important, as knowing what to ask, and not just about how much the premium costs! Know what to ask the insurance Agent/Broker that offers the home insurance and if the placement will be with an 'Admitted ' or 'Non-Admitted' insurance company. Know the insurance company's AM Best rating and JD Powers rating. Know the differences in coverage offered such as Actual cash value, Replacement Cost payouts on claims, deductibles, co-insurance penalties, home value evaluation, coverage endorsements, and building ordinance. Knowing these 3 important items will help avoid devastating surprises, understanding these factors is 'extremely' important. As we know, insurance is only as good as how the claim pays out and if it will ever payout at all. The clearinghouse program allows insurers with access to homeowner information who has insurance coverage through the FAIR Plan, in accordance with California Insurance Code Section 10095(i). The purpose is to help insurer determine if the homeowner is eligible for the normal insurance market and to offer their insurance product.What if you are a homeowner that does not want to have your information shared in the clearing house?

You can opt out of the clearinghouse by completing an opt-out request form online, which can be found at www.cfpnet.com/choo.



There is an app Is San Bernadino County Sheriff wanted to share with you called SeeClickFix that's available to download on your phone (available for download on Google play or download in the apple store. Any issues such as transients, potholes, traffic signals, weed abatement, etc can be sent to San Bernardino County Public Works through this app. You can take pictures, choose a category your complaint falls under, write a description of what the issue is, and send it to them. It's really easy and hopefully, it can get some issues you've been having taken care of. I don't have email addresses for everyone in your community, so please feel free to share.



Also, The Caltrans QuickMap web page presents several types of real-time traffic information layered on a Google Map. The information includes traffic speed, lane and road closures due to construction and maintenance activities, incident reports, Changeable Message Sign (CMS) content, camera snapshots, and active chain control requirements. Traffic speed is indicated by color-coded lines overlaying the roadway. The location of information content for the remaining layers is identified by markers (icon images) on the map. Clicking on a marker displays the information details in an info window pop-up.



MAIL THEFT SOLUTIONS

Informed Delivery by USPS is a service that allows you to receive your mail on your phone or tablet, giving you more control over when and how you want to get it. It can also be used as an online service, letting you see what's in your mailbox before it arrives at your home or office.
