

# Code Enforcement

## San Bernardino County Code Enforcement Process

(Excludes Short-term Rental, Cannabis, and Fire Hazard Abatement)



HELPFUL HINTS: The following may assist Code Enforcement staff when investigating a complaint:

- Provide address, parcel number or other specific location information.
- Provide a detailed description of what you observed.
- Leave your contact information for staff to contact you with any follow-up questions.
- If you have already taken audio, photos, or video, you may provide them via our website.

- Regarding the Devore Gas Station at 1677 Devore Rd, that is private property Code Enforcement can also contact the property owner directly to remind them of their responsibility to maintain the property and remove the graffiti. Repeated issues can result in violations
- Once complaint is filed the Code team forwards it to the county's Graffiti abatement contractor and removal typically occurs within 24 to 48 hours.

## American Flag Etiquette



-  DOs
- Respect the flag at all times.
- Display it from sunrise to sunset (or at night with a light).
- Fly it in good weather unless it's an all-weather flag.
- Hang it with the stars (blue field) at the top and to the left.
- Fold it properly into a triangle when storing.
- Retire it respectfully when worn out (usually by burning).
-  DON'Ts
- Don't let it touch the ground.
- Don't wear it as clothing.
- Don't use it for decoration (use flag-themed items instead).
- Don't fly it upside down (unless in extreme distress).
- Don't write on it or add any markings.
- Don't fly a torn or dirty flag.

### What to Do If You Find a Stray Animal

If you encounter a sick, injured, aggressive, suffering animal, or an animal obstructing traffic in the service areas of San Bernardino County Animal Care (SBCAC), please contact SBCAC immediately at (800) 472-5609.

For non-emergency animals, please scan the QR code or visit [animalcare.sbcounty.gov/report-a-lost-pet](https://animalcare.sbcounty.gov/report-a-lost-pet) to access Petco Love Lost and upload a photo of the lost pet. Petco Love Lost is a searchable national database that uses patented facial recognition technology to help reunite lost pets with their owners faster and more easily.



#### Additional Tips:

- Check for pet ID tags
- Scan for a microchip at a local veterinary clinic
- Ask neighbors and locals
- Post flyers and share on social media
- Care for or rehome the pet; taking them to an animal shelter should be a last resort

### Trap-Neuter-Vaccinate-Return (TNVR) Program for Stray Cats
