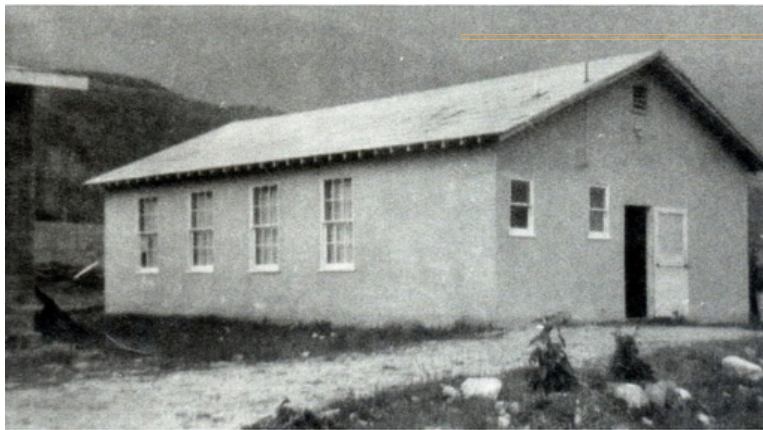
Devore History

On August 22, 1948, First Baptist Church and the American Sunday School Union officially opened the new church in Devore with a ceremony dedicating the church and presenting the deed to the land to the Southern California Region of the American Baptist Convention. The first pastor, Claude Farris, officially took over in October, 1948 and stayed through May, 1949. Rev. Christie came at that time and stayed through 1950. Bob Sorenson was the church pianist, and his mother, Cora Sorenson was one of the Sunday school teachers. Benny Bates often led the singing, and Mildred Davidson was another Sunday school teacher.

Above- in 1960 the building on its new site purchased from Mr. Dixon after the freeway condemned the original site. The steeple was removed, and the door faced south instead of east. The eaves of the new building is seen at left.

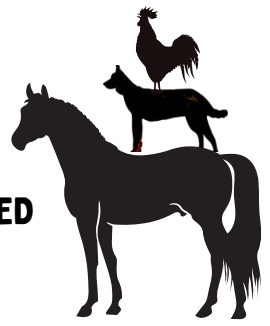
