










Devore History Credited to Alice Hall



Above--First Baptist purchased the land and furnished some materials and volunteer labor to construct the new building. Materials reaching a total of \$1,750 were advanced by Southern California Baptist Convention.

On August 22, 1948, First Baptist Church and the American Sunday School Union officially opened the new church in Devore with a ceremony dedicating the church and presenting the deed to the land to the Southern California Region of the American Baptist Convention. The first pastor, Claude Farris, officially took over in October, 1948 and stayed through May, 1949. Rev. Christie came at that time and stayed through 1950. Bob Sorenson was the church pianist, and his mother, Cora Sorenson was one of the Sunday school teachers. Benny Bates often led the singing, and Mildred Davidson was another Sunday school teacher.
