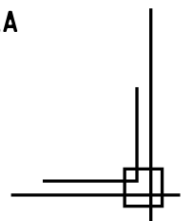
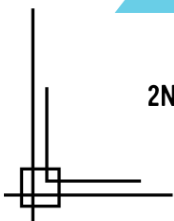

STRONG WINDS CAN CAUSE POWER LINES TO SPARK, WHICH CAN IGNITE WILDFIRES IF THERE IS DRY BRUSH AND GRASS NEARBY.

SANTA ANAS DEVELOP WHEN THE DESERT IS RELATIVELY COLD, AND ARE THUS MOST COMMON DURING THE COOL SEASON STRETCHING FROM OCTOBER THROUGH MARCH.

CAL FIRE URGES EVERYONE TO EXERCISE EXTREME CAUTION WHEN IN OR NEAR THE WILDLAND OR OPEN AREAS TO PREVENT SPARKING A FIRE. ONE LESS SPARK MEANS ONE LESS WILDFIRE. A FEW HELPFUL REMINDERS AND SAFETY TIPS

INCLUDE:

- DON'T MOW OR TRIM DRY GRASS ON WINDY DAYS
- NEVER PULL YOUR VEHICLE OVER IN DRY GRASS
- ENSURE CAMPFIRES ARE ALLOWED, AND IF SO, BE SURE TO EXTINGUISH THEM COMPLETELY
- REPORT ANY SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITIES TO PREVENT ARSON

CRIME AND SAFETY

There is an app Is San Bernadino County Sheriff wanted to share with you called **SeeClickFix that's available to download on your phone (available for download on Google play or download in the apple store. Any issues such as transients, potholes, traffic signals, weed abatement, etc can be sent to San Bernardino County Public Works through this app. You can take pictures, choose a category your complaint falls under, write a description of what the issue is, and send it to them. It's really easy and hopefully, it can get some issues you've been having taken care of. I don't have email addresses for everyone in your community, so please feel free to share.**



Also, The Caltrans QuickMap web page presents several types of real-time traffic information layered on a Google Map. The information includes traffic speed, lane and road closures due to construction and maintenance activities, incident reports, Changeable Message Sign (CMS) content, camera snapshots, and active chain control requirements. Traffic speed is indicated by color-coded lines overlaying the roadway. The location of information content for the remaining layers is identified by markers (icon images) on the map. Clicking on a marker displays the information details in an info window pop-up.

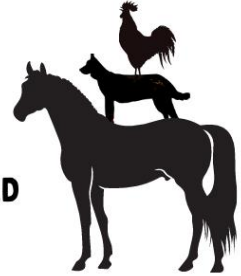
