There is an app Is San Bernadino County Sheriff wanted to share with you called SeeClickFix that's available to download on your phone (available for download on Google play or download in the apple store. Any issues such as transients, potholes, traffic signals, weed abatement, etc can be sent to San Bernardino County Public Works through this app. You can take pictures, choose a category your complaint falls under, write a description of what the issue is, and send it to them. It's really easy and hopefully, it can get some issues you've been having taken care of. I don't have email addresses for everyone in your community, so please feel free to share.

Also, The Caltrans QuickMap web page presents several types of real-time traffic information layered on a Google Map. The information includes traffic speed, lane and road closures due to construction and maintenance activities, incident reports, Changeable Message Sign (CMS) content, camera snapshots, and active chain control requirements. Traffic speed is indicated by color-coded lines overlaying the roadway. The location of information content for the remaining layers is identified by markers (icon images) on the map. Clicking on a marker displays the information details in an info window pop-up.

HOLIDAY DECORATING FIRE SAFETY TIPS

- •CHOOSE DECORATIONS THAT ARE FLAME-RESISTANT OR FLAME-RETARDANT.
- KEEP LIT CANDLES AWAY FROM DECORATIONS AND OTHER THINGS THAT CAN BURN.
- SOME LIGHTS ARE ONLY FOR INDOOR OR OUTDOOR USE, BUT NOT BOTH.
- REPLACE ANY STRING OF LIGHTS WITH WORN OR BROKEN CORDS OR LOOSE BULB CONNECTIONS. READ THE MANUFACTURER'S INSTRUCTIONS FOR SEVERAL LIGHT STRANDS TO CONNECT. USE CLIPS, NOT NAILS, TO HANG LIGHTS SO THE CORDS DO NOT GET DAMAGED.
- KEEP DECORATIONS AWAY FROM WINDOWS AND DOORS



A CUT TREE IS LIKE A CUT FLOWER - NEITHER WILL LAST VERY LONG WITHOUT WATER. A HOLIDAY TREE PURCHASED FROM A LOT, OR CUT ON A TREE FARM, CAN REMAIN RELATIVELY FIRE-RESISTANT IF YOU FOLLOW THESE SIMPLE

RECUT THE TRUNK AT LEAST ONE INCH ABOVE THE OLD CUT AS SOON AS YOU GET IT HOME. THIS REMOVES THE SCARRED TISSUE OF THE OLD CUT AND OPENS UP THE TREE VEINS ALLOWING IT TO CONTINUE TO PULL MOISTURE INTO ITS FOLIAGE. KEEP THE FRESH-CUT END OF THE TRUNK IN WATER. MOISTURE IS THE KEY TO KEEPING THE TREE FRESH AND THEREBY ENHANCING ITS FIRE RESISTANCE. PUT THE TREE IN WATER IMMEDIATELY AFTER IT IS RECUT. EVEN IF THE TREE IS SET UP IN THE HOUSE FOR A FEW DAYS, STAND IT IN A BUCKET OF WATER OUTSIDE UNTIL YOU ARE READY TO BRING IT INDOORS.

CLEAN THE STAND. BEFORE MOUNTING THE TREE IN A STURDY STAND (APPROPRIATE FOR THE SIZE OF THE TREE), RINSE THE STAND WATER RESERVOIR WITH A CAPFUL OF BLEACH MIXED IN WATER. THIS REDUCES THE GROWTH OF ORGANISMS THAT CAN BLOCK THE TREE'S INTAKE OF WATER.

LOCATE THE TREE AWAY FROM THE SOURCES OF HEAT. AVOID PLACING THE TREE NEAR A HEATER OUTLET, WOOD STOVE, OR FIREPLACE. PUT IT IN THE COOLEST LOCATION POSSIBLE. NEVER LEAVE A LIGHTED TREE UNATTENDED, AND TURN DOWN THE ROOM HEAT AT NIGHT.

CAUTION: BE CAREFUL NOT TO BLOCK A DOOR WITH THE TREE OR REARRANGED FURNITURE.

CHECK THE WATER LEVEL IN THE STAND DAILY. NEVER LET THE WATER LEVEL GO BELOW THE BOTTOM OF THE TRUNK. LUKEWARM WATER WILL BE TAKEN UP BY THE TREE MORE READILY THAN COLD WATER. COMMERCIAL FLORAL PRESERVATIVES CAN ALSO BE ADDED TO THE WATER TO HELP MAINTAIN THE FRESHNESS OF THE TREE.

CAREFULLY CONTROL THE LIGHTS ON THE TREE. STANDARD-SIZE HOLIDAY TREE LIGHTS GENERATE HEAT, WHICH

ACCELERATE THE RATE OF DRYING. THE USE OF MINIATURE LIGHTS PRODUCES SUBSTANTIALLY LESS HEAT AND THEREBY REDUCES THE DRYING EFFECT ON THE TREE. DO NOT LEAVE LIGHTS TURNED ON FOR PROLONGED PERIODS. ALWAYS TURN THE LIGHTS OFF WHEN LEAVING THE HOUSE OR RETIRING FOR THE NIGHT. CAUTION: ELECTRICAL WIRING DETERIORATES WITH AGE. ALWAYS CHECK LIGHT SETS FOR FRAYED OR CRACKED WIRES AND BROKEN SOCKETS BEFORE PLACING THEM ON THE TREE. DO NOT ATTEMPT TO REPAIR A WORN LIGHT SET! THROW IT AWAY AND PURCHASE A NEW REPLACEMENT.

REMOVE THE TREE IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE HOLIDAYS. EVEN A PROPERLY CARED FOR CUT TREE WILL CONTINUE
TO DRY OUT FROM THE EFFECTS OF THE HOMES ENVIRONMENT. REMOVE IT FROM THE HOUSE IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE HOLIDAYS,
AND CUT AND BUNDLE IT. TAKE IT TO A RECYCLE CENTER OR LEAVE FOR YOUR REFUSE COLLECTOR. CAUTION: NEVER BURN A
TREE IN A WOOD STOVE OR FIREPLACE.
