1. Live Nation and Kimley-Horn & Associates, a noted engineering and traffic consulting firm, have prepared a comprehensive Traffic Operations Plan, in conjunction with the California Highway Patrol, San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department, and SP Parking.
2. Electronic message boards and other additional signage with event specific information and advisories will be prominently displayed.
3. San Bernardino County Sheriff's and venue security personnel have been hired to patrol the neighborhood and surrounding areas.
4. Our receptionists will be working diligently to take any calls regarding suspicious persons or non-sound complaints. That number is 909-880-6500.
5. We will have a **Noise Complaint Hotline** available to take all noise related calls. That number is 909-495-3610.

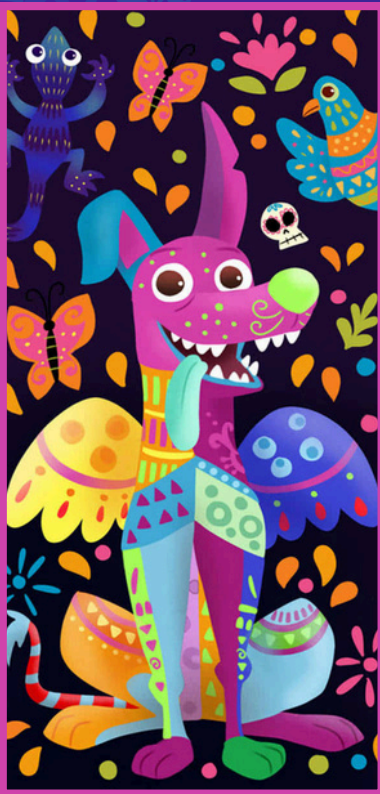

With free SeeClickFix mobile app and web tools, citizens will now be able to provide County Public Works and Special Districts officials with pictures, videos, specific descriptions, and more. The SeeClickFix citizen reporting solution feeds valuable information needed to get the job done efficiently directly to the newly implemented centralized operations, asset and issue management system to manage issues from creation to resolution — engaging County citizens throughout the process.

How do I report an issue with SeeClickFix?

The SeeClickFix mobile app is available for download on Google Play Store for Android and Apple App Store for iPhone. In addition to the mobile apps, citizens can send reports to the SB County Public Works using the form below.

Requests that are reported after hours will be addressed during our normal working hours of Monday thru Thursday 8:00 – 4:30 p.m.. For life threatening emergencies, please contact 911. For issues that should be addressed immediately, such as potholes or Stop signs down, after hours only please report to Comm Center at 909-356-3805.

WHEN YOU ENCOUNTER A STRAY ANIMAL IN THE COMMUNITY

Please verify the lost pet was found within our service area. Visit animalcare.sbcounty.gov/ServiceAreas.

What to Do If You Find a Stray Animal

If you encounter a sick, injured, aggressive, suffering animal, or an animal obstructing traffic in the service areas of San Bernardino County Animal Care (SBCAC), please contact SBCAC immediately at (800) 472-5609.

For non-emergency animals, please scan the QR code or visit animalcare.sbcounty.gov/report-a-lost-pet to access Petco Love Lost and upload a photo of the lost pet. Petco Love Lost is a searchable national database that uses patented facial recognition technology to help reunite lost pets with their owners faster and more easily.



Additional Tips:

- Check for pet ID tags
- Scan for a microchip at a local veterinary clinic
- Ask neighbors and locals
- Post flyers and share on social media
- Care for or rehome the pet; taking them to an animal shelter should be a last resort

Trap-Neuter-Vaccinate-Return (TNVR) Program for Stray Cats

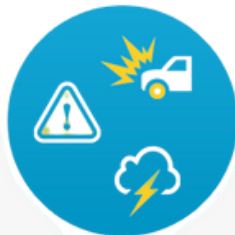


